Thank you for entering the 2018 Traegers Earthmoving SA Dirt Track Championship. A special welcome to our interstate competitors and we hope you enjoy the event.

The Mud'n'Tars Dirt Track Circuit is located at 13 Day Road, Victor Harbor SA 5211, only minutes from the centre of town and local accommodation. Unfortunately camping is not permitted at the track.

Full catering & bar facilities will be available on the day, with great spectator viewing around most of the track. Spectator admission will be \$10 with under 14yrs free.

Riders will be on a gate list with a +1 free admission for mechanic or support crew.

No Dogs permitted at the event, with the exception for guide dogs.

Enviro Mats MUST be used when re fuelling. If you do not have one they will be for sale at sign on for \$5 each.

The Supp Regs are available on the Mud'n'Tars website and contain all event info. Riders must read them and be familiar with the format for the day. www.mudntars.com

Back numbers are COMPULSORY. It is your responsibility to make sure your numbers are legible for the lap scorers. Transponders will not be used this year.

Riders must sign on at the clubrooms before proceeding to scrutineering. Please present your MA Licence at sign on.

To ensure the event runs to schedule it is very important riders are punctual and on time to sign on & scrutineering. The event has to conclude by 10pm so in order to complete the full program please be organised. Races will not be held up for late riders, if you are late to the start line the gate will not be held for you.

Competitors also please note there will be limited lighting in the pit area. If you need light to work on bikes etc please make sure you are prepared.
